

April 50/50 Winner


This time it was Addison Dunmore, richer now by \$11.50.

A new place to exhibit your work and promote carving


In August there is an open air fair in Dayton's Carillon Park. It's called The 2018 Dayton Mini Maker Faire. Check out their website, dayton.makerfaire.com.

The Dayton Mini Maker Faire is a family-orientated community festival that brings together science, art, craft, engineering and history plus music, food, workshops, and performance. It's a gathering for makers to show their work and interact with others about it. The exhibits are very diverse.

They'd like some woodcarvers. There is no fee to participate if you are *not* selling or promoting a product. Should you sell, there is a \$75 fee. The 2018 Dayton Mini Maker Faire will be held August 4-5.
