Sandy Gordon owned the winning ticket. She traded that for a carving knife.

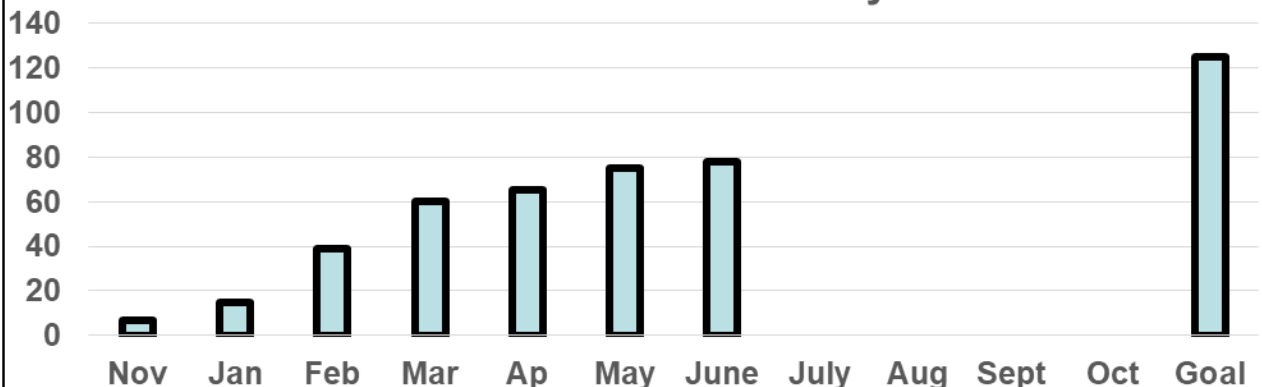
June 50/50
