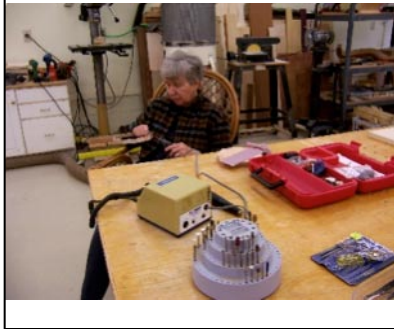
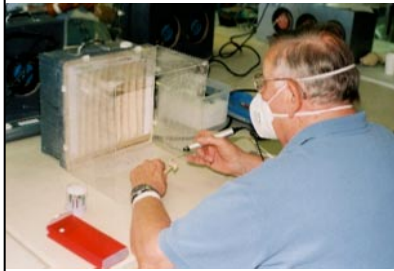
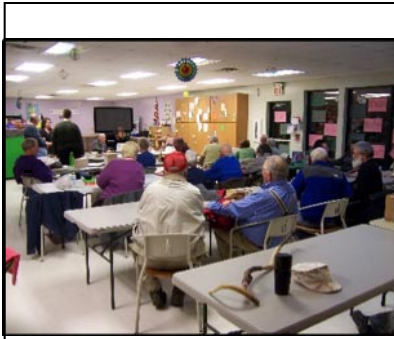
Jim Reboulet of Dayton was a member long ago. We hope to see you again, Jim.
