After a day or so more complications began happening and Mary Rose declined. On Thursday, August 17, she was moved to Hospice of Dayton. Yesterday morning [August 21] around 9:35 am Mary Rose died at Hospice.

“We have been trying to contact her friends and have been concerned about the Wood Carvers. She delighted in the wood carving.

“Her funeral Mass will be on Thursday, August 24th at our Salem Heights chapel at 4960 Salem Avenue.”

Marion’s reeked of garlic.

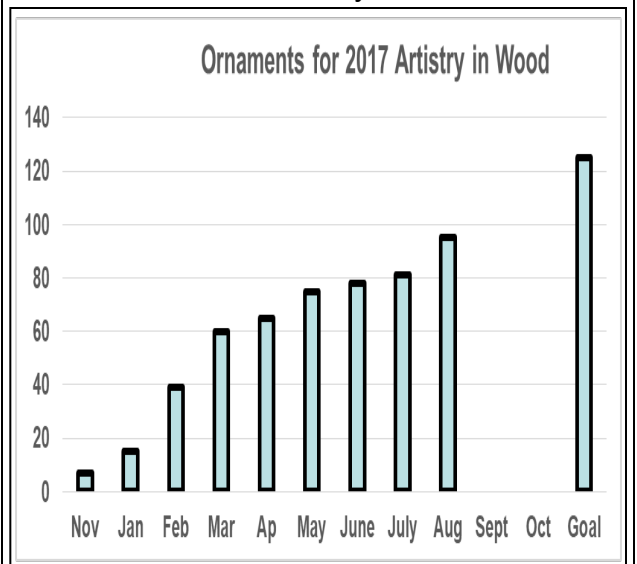

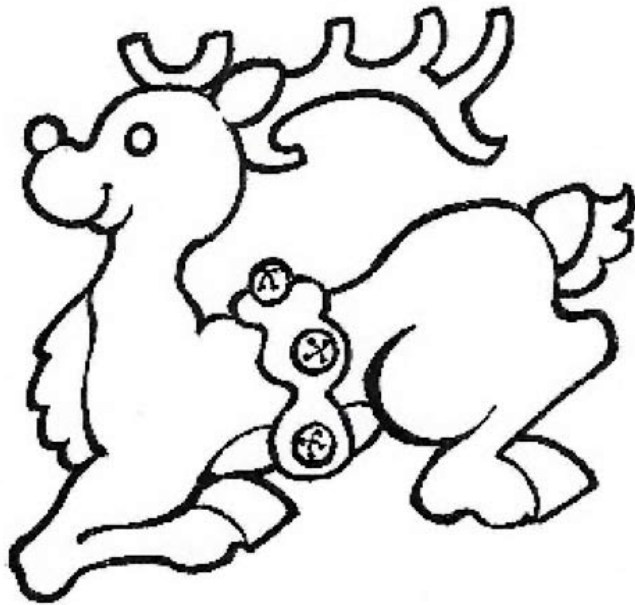
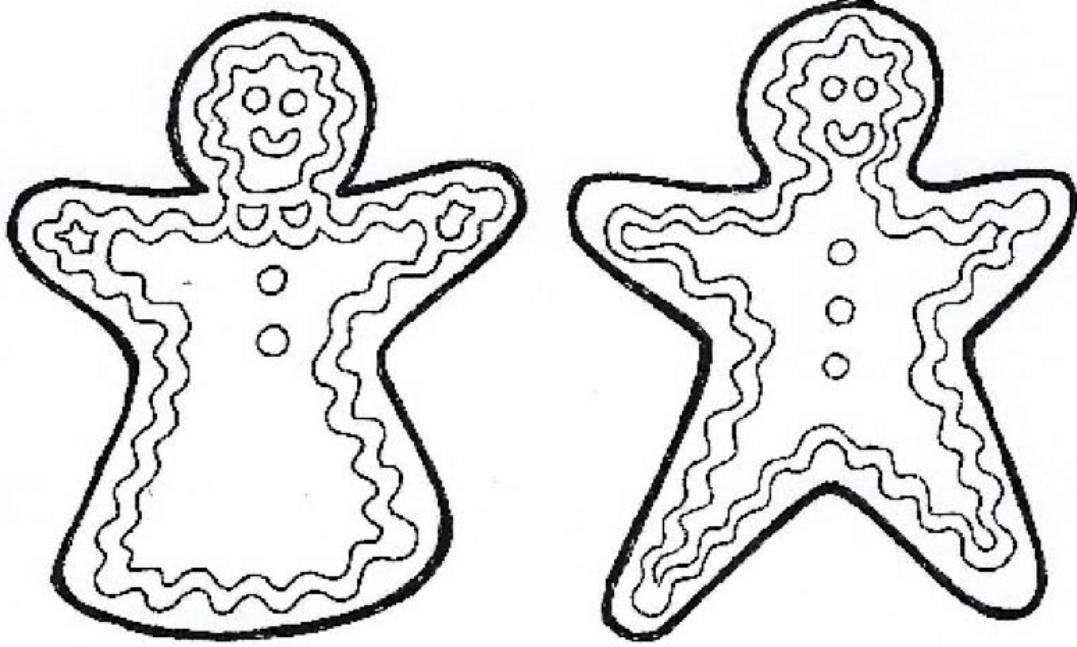
