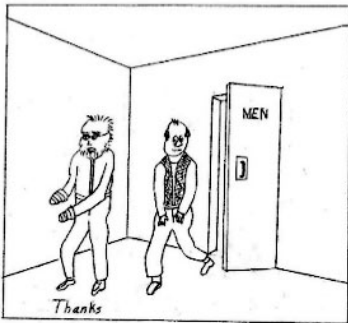

From what I hear, Taxus is a very dense wood, hard when dry and carveable when green.

Centuries ago it was chosen for bows. Cane and walking stick carvers and turners like it. Taxus can also be called Yew. Tom's range from thin to maybe 6 inches in diameter. Someone said the foliage can effect you as does poison ivy.

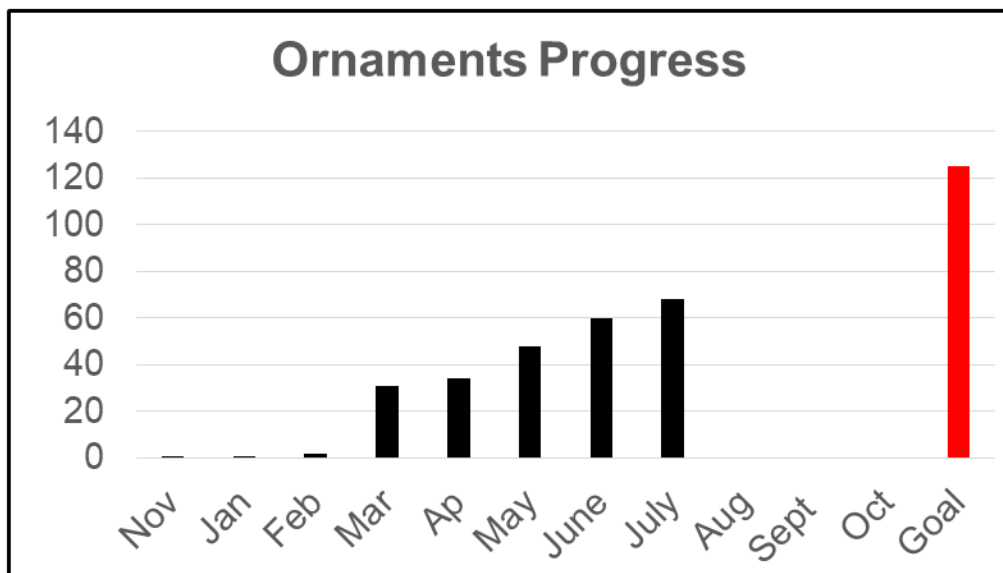
It was Lee Stearns who chose a leather finger guard, too late.
